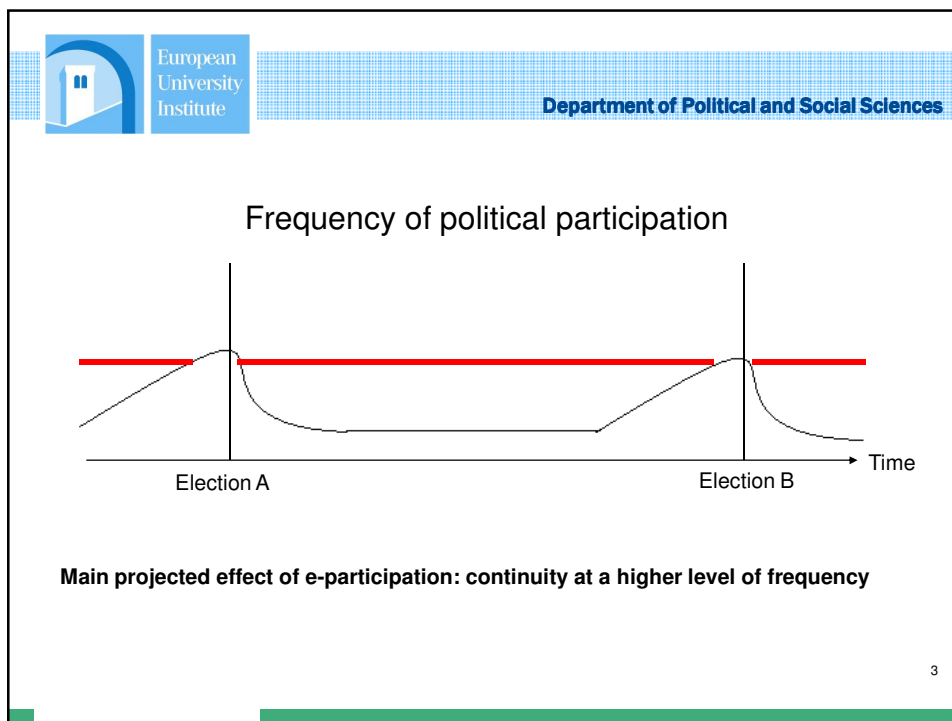

5. Boost citizens' demands
6. Boost shifts in the political offer

- Brings more convenience for political participation
- New forms of political participation
- Non-mediated creation of political networks
- Stimulation of political interest
- Top-down and bottom-up consultations
